Ancaster Skating Club COVID-19 SESSION PROTOCOLS

PreCANSkate, CANSkate, AdvancedCANSkate & CanPOWERSkate Programs Updated July 27, 2021

These protocols have been established to comply with Provincial, City of Hamilton and Skate Ontario COVID-19 requirements, and may need to be updated from time to time. In order to participate in programs at the Ancaster Skating Club, parents/guardians and skaters are required to adhere to the following COVID-19 Protocols. A copy of these protocols can be found on the ASC website. Parents/guardians are also asked to review the ASC COVID Response Plan, also found on the ASC website.

PREPARING FOR YOUR FIRST SESSION:

1. Parents/skaters must complete and bring a signed Skate Ontario COVID-19 waiver to their first session in the 2020/2021 season (skaters will NOT be permitted on the ice without providing this completed form); a copy of the form is available on the Club's website, and will also be emailed to all registered participants prior to their first session.
2. At home and prior to coming to each and every skating session, parents/skaters must complete the appropriate Ministry of Health Screening Questionnaire. If the answers to any of the questions is "Yes", do not come to the rink; do not bring a hardcopy of this form with you to the rink. A copy of the form is available on the Club's website, and will also be emailed to all registered participants prior to their first session.
3. As of July 16, 2021, skaters can use change rooms to put skates on.

WHEN AT THE RINK:

4. For the first session, please bring along your completed Skate Ontario COVID Waiver to provide to the Club (if you have not already provided one during the 2020-2021 season).
5. Parents (and siblings) may now accompany skaters into the rink facility; parents (and siblings) are considered to be Spectators, and must adhere to all requirements outlined in this policy.
6. Skaters and parent(s)/guardian(s) may enter the rink about 15 minutes prior to their session, and proceed to the designated rink and change room.
7. Skaters and parent(s)/guardian(s) are to verbally provide their screening results to the ASC volunteer or coach as they enter the designated rink.
8. Masks must be worn by everyone (parents/guardians, skaters, and coaches) when inside the rink facility, and when NOT on the ice surface. Skaters may remove their masks when on the ice.
9. During the session, parents/guardians may stay and watch the session, while practicing social distancing and staying in designated locations within the rink.
10. Parents/guardians may return with their skater at the end of the session to the change room to remove skates.

11. Failure to follow COVID-19 protocols can result in the facility being fined, spectators not being allowed in the facility, and/or other consequences; the ASC also reserves the right to suspend or terminate a skater's privileges for failure to adhere to these protocols.
